

# BLUE RIDGE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION OPEN SHOW

## INFORMATION SHEET

**Time** - The show will begin 8:30 Saturday morning with class 1 in ring 2.

**Futurity Classes** - Futurity classes are for partbred and purebred Arabian horses eligible to compete in the Maryland Futurity. Futurity horses may enter in futurity classes, youth classes, and open classes. Futurity horses competing in walk/trot performance futurity classes may enter walk/trot /canter performance futurity classes in that same discipline.

**Jackpot** - Jackpot is offered in payout futurity halter classes (weanlings through 3 years old). The fee is \$10.00 and the highest placed jackpot horse in a class receives the entire jackpot amount for that class. Amount of jackpot depends on the number of horses in a class that are entered in the jackpot.

**Get Of Sire/Produce Of Dam** - Entries for get of sire and produce of dam must consist of at least two (2) futurity eligible animals (weanlings through 4 years of age) entered under the name of the sire or dam. Sires are not permitted in the ring and dams only with unweaned foals.

**Open Classes** - All classes designated as Open Partbred Arabian are open to all registered partbred Arabian horses. All classes designated as Open Purebred Arabian are open to all registered purebred Arabian horses. All classes designated as Open All Breed are open to all breeds of horses. In the open performance classes, horses may enter both walk/trot (jog) and walk/trot (jog)/canter (lope) classes.

**Junior and Senior Classes** - All junior classes are for exhibitors 17 years and younger. All senior classes are for exhibitors 18 years and older.

**Junior Horse Classes** - Open to horses that are 5 years old or younger.

**Green Classes** - Horse and rider combination that has not competed more than two years together in that discipline.

**Maiden Classes** - Horse or rider may not have won more than one blue ribbon in that discipline.

**Novice Classes** - Horse or rider may not have won more than three blue ribbons in that discipline.

**Halter Handling** - Trail course beside your horse. Horses will be led over various obstacles. Halter handling will be in the Schooling Ring. No specific order will be assigned for entering the class. Starting time will be 12:00. Halter Handling and Trail classes will be open for 4 hours and 30 minutes. Futurity horses can compete in classes 113 through 117. Class 121 is open to purebred Arabian horses. Class 122 is open to partbred Arabian horses. Classes 118, 119, 120 and 123 are open to all breeds of horses. Registrations for these classes are to be by 10:00 am on the day of the show.

**Trail Class** - Horses will be ridden over various obstacles. Trail classes will be in the Schooling Ring. No specific order will be assigned for entering the class. Class 127 is open to Purebred Arabian horses. Class 128 is open to partbred Arabian horses. Classes 124, 125, 126 and 129 are open to all breeds of horses. Registrations for these classes are to be by 10:00 am on the day of the show.

**Liberty Classes** - Futurity Liberty is open only to futurity horses except weanlings. No weanlings allowed. Open Liberty is for non-futurity eligible horses except weanlings and is limited to 10 horses. Two handlers may be used. You will have 1 ½ minutes in the ring and 2 minutes to catch your horse. Horses who are not caught within the time limit will be disqualified. No noise makers may be used.

**Sport Horse Classes** - All sport horse classes will begin at 10:30. The order will be assigned for entering the class. You may enter more than one sport horse class if eligible. Sport horse classes must be pre-entered. Class times will be posted. There is a limit of 50 entries for Sport Horse classes and Sport Horse classes will close 15 minutes after the last posted entry time.

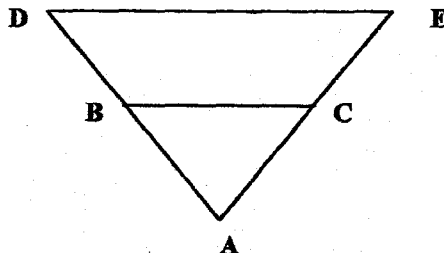
**Sport Horse Eligibility** - Futurity horses can compete in classes 130 through 134. All purebred Arabian horses can compete in class 138. All partbred Arabian horses can compete in class 139. Classes 135, 136, 137 and 140 are open to all breeds of horses.

**Timed Classes** - Those who enter the speed classes cannot enter the walk/jog classes in the same discipline unless it is used as a warmup. Tiedowns, splint boots and two hands on reins are allowed in all classes. Helmets are required for all riders.

**Go As You Please Classes** – Horses will enter the ring at a walk and then will be asked to “Go As You Please” (trot/jog, canter/lope) both ways of the ring.

**Sport Horse Judging and Pattern** - Horses will be shown in hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. For this show, bridles or halters may be used when showing your horse in the sport horse classes. The sport horse class is scored as follows: 60% movement, 30% conformation, and 10% general impressions. Horses will be individually judged on the triangle.

**Triangle** - The triangle measures approximately 30 meters on the long side and 22 meters on each of the short sides. When called by the ring master, present your horse at “A” for conformation judging. Upon direction, follow the procedure as diagramed below:

**Sponsorship Forms** – Enclosed you will find a sponsorship form. We would greatly appreciate your support in sponsoring a class or classes. Advertisement will be provided to anyone sponsoring a class. Money collected from sponsorships will be used to cover expenses of show.

**Registration and Coggins papers** – a copy of a coggins for all horses and registration papers for purebred and partbred Arabians must accompany entry form. Coggins must be within one year of show date. A weanling 6 months of age or younger may use the dam’s coggins. Weanlings over 6 months of age will require their own coggins. All horses who are yearlings and older must have registration papers. If your weanling has not been registered by the show, a copy of the dam’s registration papers will be sufficient.

**Stalling** – Stalls will be available Saturday afternoon at 2:00. The cost per stall will be \$25.00 for the weekend. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING YOUR OWN BEDDING. YOU MUST USE STRAW FOR YOUR BEDDING. ANY BEDDING OTHER THAN STRAW WILL BE SUBJECTED TO AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$25.00.** If it is your desire to be stalled next to certain individuals, please make sure that you include that information with your entry. If you wish to stay over Sunday evening, please inform the show office.

**Camper Spaces** – Available for the weekend for \$35.00.

**Discourtesy** toward the judge or show officials before, during or after the show by an exhibitor or by any person associated with an exhibitor will result in the forfeiture of all awards and/or monies. Failure to settle your show debt prior to departure from the show grounds without permission of the show office will result in the forfeiture of all awards and/or monies. There will be a \$35.00 charge for all returned checks.

**Pre-entries** – Pre-entries must be postmarked by September 1, 2010. You are encouraged to pre-enter the show. By doing so, any additional classes that you enter will be honored at that fee. Refunds for cancelled classes and/or stalls will be made within two weeks after the show. Please remember to fill out ADD/DROP forms on the day of the show.

**Directions** – I-95 North to exit 77 – Route 24 North, Bel Air, 5 miles to left on Business Route 1, ½ mile to right on Tollgate Road, ¼ mile to Equestrian Center on left.
