Proper attire and tack are required. Each in-hand or ridden test will be followed by personal discussion with the judge providing a mini clinic opportunity. This show will follow USDF, USEF, and AHA rules. Please see the USEF Rule Book for complete explanation of sport horse in-hand & dressage competitions. The arena is an indoor facility.

Awards will be given to each class for 1st - 6th place. Within Sport Horse, a Champion ribbon/trophy and a Reserve ribbon will be given to the 2 highest scoring Arabian, 2 highest scoring Partbred Arabian, and 2 highest scoring Other Breed horses. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Awards will be made to the two highest scoring individual horses within the Sport Horse Division. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded for Intro, Training, First Level and Second/Third Level Dressage Divisions to the two highest scoring individual horses within each division. Three highpoint trophies will be awarded at the end of the show to the highest scoring Arabian, Partbred Arabian, and Other Breed horses in Dressage.

All classes must be pre-entered. Opening date is April 3, 2009. Closing Date is May 4, 2009. Entry forms must be in the show secretary's hand by May 4th to enable the scheduling of sport horse times & ride times. Times will be emailed if an email address is provided on the entry form or by phone (301.371.5434) on May 7th between 7PM and 8:30 PM. No refunds will be given after May 7, 2009 for any reason.

Sport Horse: Horses will be shown in hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Bridles are optional on two-year olds, mandatory on horses three years old and older. A bridle shall be a dressage or hunter type with snaffle bit with or without cheeks, keepers allowed, reins, and headstall with throatlatch. Noseband is optional. A split or single chain may be used with/or instead of reins. Horses under the age of two must be shown in plain leather stable halters. Conservative attire is recommended for the handler. The handler may carry one whip.

Dressage: 2007 tests will be used. A horse may be entered only once in a given test, however a rider may ride more than 1 horse in the same test. Second/Third Level Dressage tests- - exhibitors may choose which test(s) they would like to ride in Second/Third Level. A rider may compete with more than one horse riding the same test, and/or the same horse and rider combination may ride more than one test at that level.

If special time accommodations are needed, please indicate on the entry form. If possible these needs will be accommodated. However show management wishes to make every effort to complete an individual class in a consecutive fashion.
